The rest of the year we will be gathering items for the Warming Shelter and Gospel Mission in Sioux City. A big thanks go out to those who contribute to each of our mission projects and make the trips to deliver the items.

During a time where there is so much sadness, so many wars, so much killing and destruction, we can still be thankful for the generosity we can show to so many people who have so much less than we do.

This year as you sit down to your bountiful Thanksgiving dinner, thank God that you have a roof over your head, a warm home to live in, plenty of food on your table and a life that abounds with love. It doesn't get any better than that!!!

Finance: Marilyn Hladik called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. and Lav Pastor Shirley gave the devotions. Present were Andrea Mitchell, JoLynne Reimert, Deanna Adler, Marilyn Hladik, and Lay Pastor Shirley Nelson. The Profit and Loss statement was reviewed. JoLynne made a motion to pay the apportionments for 2024(\$5952) and the unfunded pension obligation of \$19,549. Deanna seconded it . Motion carried. Andrea Mitchell made a motion to have JoLynne cash in CD"s at the UBI as they mature with \$867.52 going into Missions and \$2000 into Capital Campaign with JoLynne seconding it. Motion passed.

Board: Andrea called the meeting to order. JoLynne made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Deanna 2nd it. Motion passed.

Pastor: Shirley reported plans are made for Laity Sunday Oct.15. Thrasher is scheduled to do work the week of Oct. 31. Sue Wilson has volunteered to clean the church windows. Tim Hoy will do a service in Nov. Shirley will work on nominations for committees.

Finance: We have assets of \$62,455.11. The committee has requested JoLynne cash in CD's and pay funds needed to continue with the dissafiliation process.

Trustees: Shirley would like the weatherstripping on the back door checked.

Teaching: A tentative date for the Youth Christmas program is Dec. 10.

Mission: Marilyn reported they are finishing the kits for the In-Gathering and will be starting a new project soon, Gospel Mission, Warming Shelter. Any suggestions for new projects are appreciated.

SPRC: Will meet in Nov.

OLd business: Final agreement is signed, we need to send archive of minutes, baptisms, and weddings.

New business: Nov.18 is a zoom charge conference. The hymnals belong to us. We will ask Mike Kerns, Tim& Judd hoy to remove the flame from outside of church. Hanging of the greens is Nov.26.

We discussed having a soup supper on Dec.3 The youth and JoLynne will help.

We need to change the name of the church on the website and facebook.

The next meeting will be Nov. 13 with JoLynne giving devotions.

Shirley closed with prayer. JoLynne made a motion to adjourn and Deanna seconded it. Passed.
